

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-4 RELATING TO AND REGULATING THE USE AND OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATVS), MINI-TRUCKS, AND UTILITY TASK VEHICLES (UTVS) IN THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Cottonwood, Minnesota, hereby ordains:

Section 1. Applicability. Is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Applicability. This Ordinance applies to the operation of all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), mini-trucks, and utility task vehicles (UTVs) on public lands, private property, public rights-of-way within the boundaries of the City of Cottonwood.

Section 2. Definitions. Paragraphs A & C are amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Definitions.

- A. All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs): "All-terrain vehicle" means a motorized vehicle with: (1) not less than three, but not more than six low pressure or non-pneumatic tires; (2) a total dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less; and (3) a total width from outside of tire rim to outside tire rim that is 65 inches or less. All-terrain vehicle includes a class 1 all-terrain vehicle and class 2 all-terrain vehicle. All-terrain vehicle does not include a golf cart, mini-truck, dune buggy, or go-cart or a vehicle designed and used specifically for lawn maintenance, agricultural, logging, or mining purposes.
 - i. "Class 1 all-terrain vehicle" means an all-terrain vehicle that has a total width from outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim that is 50 inches or less.
 - ii. "Class 2 - all-terrain vehicle" means an all-terrain vehicle that has a total width from outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim that is greater than 50 inches, but not more 65 inches.
- C. Utility Task Vehicle (UTVs) as defined by Minnesota Statute §169.045, Subd. 1(3), a side-by-side, four-wheel drive, off-road vehicle that has four wheels, is propelled by an internal combustion engine with a piston displacement capacity of 1,200 cubic centimeters or less, and has a total dry weight of 1,800, but not less than 2,600 pounds.

Section 10. Conditions. Paragraph A is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Conditions.

- A. ATVs and UTVs may only be operated on designated routes from sunrise to sunset, unless equipped with original equipment headlights, taillights and rear-facing brake lights. They shall not be operated in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog or other conditions, or any time when there is insufficient visibility to clearly see persons and vehicles on the roadway at a distance of 500 feet.


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 2010-3 RELATING TO AND REGULATING THE USE AND OPERATION OF MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS, AND OTHER MOTORIZED CARTS IN THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Cottonwood, Minnesota, hereby ordains:

Paragraph A of Section 7. Conditions is amended to read as follows:

- A. Motorized golf carts, or other mortorized carts may only be operated on designated routes from sunrise to sunset, unless equiped with original equipment headlights, taillights and rear-facing brake lights. They shall not be operated in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog or other conditions, or at any time when there is insufficient visibility to clearly see persons and vehicles on the roadway at a distance of 500 feet.
